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DEVELOPMENT OF A TRAINING PROGRAM FOR ENHANCING THE USE OF ICT TOOLS IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF PRECISION AGRICULTURE

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1 Objectives

The objectives of this practical session are to complete the whole TP5 module by a demonstration of equipment in situation through field visits.

- To confront the opinion of the user and or the manufacturer or the distributor (if present)
- Test the multi-criteria cost-benefit analysis developed during practical session n°3.

2 Selection of sites

The visit sites will be defined according to the local potentialities in terms of breeding, greenhouses, farms using weed control robots.

3 Program of the visit

Ideally, a visit includes :

- a description of the context by the farmer/user, the equipment distributor or the manufacturer
- a demonstration of the equipment and answering questions about its operation and the advantages/disadvantages for the user
- a survey based on a multi-criteria cost-benefit analysis and the elaboration of a cost-benefit for the non-economic criteria
- a report
